### **Ravenstonedale Community & Heritage Centre**

The meeting was held in the newly refurbished Upper Room and all present were able to see the improvements, now complete apart from some electric sockets to be fitted.

## **Highways – Gritting**

Major problem in Ravenstonedale is caused mainly by unregulated parking at the Town Foot corner, obstructing passage for the gritter and large vehicles (including Buses and Emergency Services).

Suggested solutions, involving advisory signage, had been received from Highways. All those present, including Town Foot residents and Black Swan licensee, were able to study the suggested road markings plans displayed.

It was resolved that a combination of the two suggested solutions should be adopted. Clerk to notify Highways.

## **Planning**

#### No. E/12/1 Black Swan Hotel

**Proposed** full planning permission for siting 3 No. canvas bell tents, 1 No. composting toilet and 1 No outdoor shower within the hotel garden between 1st April - 30th September annually, to provide dog friendly accommodation in association with the hotel facilities.

Councillors considered many aspects of this application including the visual impact in the conservation area of Ravenstonedale, possible effects on the Scandal Beck SSSI, noise, waste disposal, safety of stoves in tents, parking facilities and dog control.

All points appeared to have been covered in the applicant's written submission. No objections had been received from occupiers of neighbouring properties.
